- SUBJECT: New Waste Discharge Requirements: Master Reclamation Permit with WDRs for the SRTTP U.S. Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton (Tentative Order No. R9-2009-0021). (Robert Pierce)
- PURPOSE: The Regional Board will consider adoption of a Master Reclamation Permit for the discharge of tertiary treated water from Camp Pendleton's Southern Region Tertiary Treatment Plant (SRTTP) for landscape irrigation.
- PUBLIC NOTICE: A public notice of the tentative Order was published in the San Diego Union-Tribune on July 26, 2008. The tentative Order was posted on the Regional Board web site on August 11, 2008. The USMC and selected federal, state and local agencies were notified of the tentative Order and opportunity to comment in letters or emails sent August 13, 2008. The public hearing for the tentative Order was postponed from the September 10, 2008, November 12, 2008 and February 11, 2009 Board Meeting at the USMC request.
- DISCUSSION: The errata sheet for the Technical Report (Supporting Document No. 3) includes correct Board members and changes to the basis for specification 6.
