SUBJECT: TENTATIVE ORDER NO. R9-2010-0003; NPDES PERMIT NO. CAG679001; GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES OF HYDROSTATIC TEST WATER AND POTABLE WATER TO SURFACE WATERS AND STORM DRAINS OR OTHER CONVEYANCE SYSTEMS WITHIN THE SAN DIEGO REGION

Enclosed is a copy of Tentative Order No. R9-2010-0003, NPDES Permit No. CAG679001, including a monitoring and reporting program and fact sheet which San Diego Water Board staff intends to present to the San Diego Water Board for adoption at their regularly scheduled meeting on August 11, 2010.

If adopted, tentative Order No. R9-2010-0003, NPDES Permit No. CAG679001, would update waste discharge requirements for the discharge of waste associated with hydrostatic test water and potable water to surface waters within the San Diego Region. If adopted, Order No. R9-2010-0003 would supersede Order No. R9-2002-0020, except for enforcement purposes.
