The City of Del Mar is concerned that the HMP monitoring requirements, as outlined in the Tentative Resolution, have a serious potential to create an unnecessary economic burden during a time when municipal funds are scarce, and many jurisdictions are taking drastic measures to balance their budgets. Recognizing that monitoring is a necessary part of these programs, the City of Del Mar supports the level of monitoring proposed by the County, and believe that these levels meet the needs of this program.

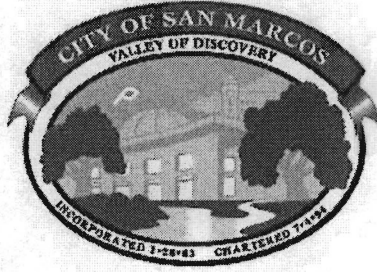
Dear Ms. Arias:
