Penalty Calculation Method (Chiara Clemente)

PURPOSE: To provide information about the process for calculating

administrative penalty amounts, as described in the State Water Resources Control Board Water Quality Enforcement

Policy (2010).

DISCUSSION: In 2010, the State Water Resources Control Board (State

Board) adopted the Water Quality Enforcement Policy

(Policy) (supporting Document No. 1). The goal of the Policy is to "protect and enhance the quality of the waters of the State by defining an enforcement process that addresses water quality problems in the most efficient, effective, and consistent manner." To provide a consistent approach in the analysis of the factors that determine monetary assessments in enforcement cases statewide. Section VI of the Policy sets

forth a process for calculating penalties.

The Director of State Board's Office of Enforcement, Cris

Carrigan, will provide an overview of this calculation

methodology, along with some relevant sample cases. The discussion will be focused on general concepts, and no specific, pending enforcement cases will be discussed.
