Letter of Support from the City of Oceanside

The San Diego Water Board received a letter from the City of Oceanside (City) on June 24, 2014 (Supporting Document No. 6) that states the City's support for Tentative Resolution No. R9-2014-0020, and the commitment to address the impairment of the Loma Alta Slough through the development and implementation of the Water Quality Improvement Plan. The Loma Alta Creek Watershed lies almost entirely within the City of Oceanside and therefore the City will be responsible to taking the required actions to restore Loma Alta Slough.
