Dear Ms. Chan:

In response to the Tentative Order No. R0-2016-0127, An Order Rescinding Orders Nos. 86-24, 88-44, and 94-46 for the Waste Discharge Requirements Orders for the County of Orange General Services Agency regarding the "Los Pinos Forestry Camp Orange County" dated June 10, 2016, I would like to inform you that at this time the Los Pinos Camp is now a vacant facility. Orange County Probation Department vacated the facility in 2009 and since that time has negotiated permit closure terms with the Cleveland National Forest (Forest) while performing deferred maintenance activities. At this time, the Forest has accepted a proposal for occupancy from the California Conservation Corps (CCC) for a proposed occupation of July 1, 2017. For the interim period, a minimal security guard presence for 24 hours/7 days per week will be used.

The Forest is requesting that the Water Board allow the planned new tenant, CCC, make application for the Waste Discharge Requirements prior to their occupancy planned for 2017 and during this period of non-use and associated minimal wastewater use of a single individual (security guard) that no monitoring be performed during this timeframe since no wastewater discharges will occur.
