**Subject: Palomar Oceanside Plant Inspection Summary** 

Mr. Bassette:

This letter provides you with a summary of inspection observations and an evaluation for potential enrollment in Waiver No. 9 – *Discharges of Slurries to Land* (Slurry Waiver). The Slurry Waiver is one of the conditional waivers adopted by the San Diego Water Board, as part of Order No. R9-2014-0041 – *Conditional Waiver of Waste Discharge Requirements for Low Threat Discharges in the San Diego Region* (Order No. R9-2014-0041) on June 26, 2014. San Diego Water Board staff conducted an inspection of the Palomar Oceanside Plant (Facility), operated by CEMEX Materials Pacific, LLC (CEMEX), on March 9, 2016. This letter only addresses observations made by San Diego Water Board staff, regarding compliance with Order No. 88-37 – *Waste Discharge Requirements for CEMEX Materials Pacific, LLC, Palomar Oceanside Batch Plant, San Diego County* (Order),<sup>2</sup> and the potential to enroll the Facility in the Slurry Waiver.

## Inspection Findings

- 1. <u>Observed Violations.</u> During the inspection of the Facility, San Diego Water Board staff did not observe any violations against the requirements specified in the Order.
- 2. <u>Enrollment Potential.</u> During the inspection, San Diego Water Board staff conferred with CEMEX's Environmental Manager and Area Manager for the Inland Empire Mix Division, and concurred the Facility is viable for enrollment in the Slurry Waiver.

### **Determination and Next Steps**

Based on the inspection findings, the San Diego Water Board considers the Facility to be in good standing, and remains a candidate for enrollment in the Slurry Waiver. As such CEMEX must maintain compliance with the requirements specified in the Order, and the associated monitoring and reporting program, until otherwise directed in writing, by the San Diego Water Board.
