## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT

Tentative Order No. R9-2021-0199 amending Order No. R9-2019-0166 as amended by Order No. R9-2020-0190, NPDES No. CA0107433,

Waste Discharge Requirements for the City of Oceanside San Luis Rey Water Reclamation Facility, La Salina Wastewater Treatment Plant, and Mission Basin Groundwater Purification Facility Discharge to the Pacific Ocean through the Oceanside Ocean Outfall

#### **Please Take Notice**

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) is releasing for public review and comment, Tentative Order No. R9-2021-0199 amending Order No. R9-2019-0166 as amended by Order No. R9-2020-0190, NPDES No. CA0107433, Waste Discharge Requirements for the City Of Oceanside San Luis Rey Water Reclamation Facility, La Salina Wastewater Treatment Plant, and Mission Basin Groundwater Purification Facility Discharge to the Pacific Ocean through the Oceanside Ocean Outfall (Tentative Order). The Tentative Order proposes to make amendments to Order No. R9-2019-0166 as directed by the California State Water Resources Control Board's (State Water Board's) on remand pursuant to Order WQ 2021-0005, as well as to more accurately describe the City's outfall structures, include proposed treatment facilities at the San Luis Rey Water Reclamation Facility, update the monitoring and reporting program to be consistent with recently adopted NPDES permits in the San Diego Region, and correct non-substantive typographical errors.

The San Luis Rey Water Reclamation Facility (SLRWRF) and the La Salina Wastewater Treatment Plant (LSWTP) provides municipal wastewater treatment services to a population of approximately 180,000 within the boundaries of the City of Oceanside and a portion of the City of Vista. Additionally, the SLRWRF serves a population of approximately 10,000 within the Rainbow Municipal Water District. The Mission Basin Groundwater Purification Facility is a groundwater desalination plant that treats local brackish groundwater to produce potable water, 15 percent of the City of Oceanside's water supply, and discharges the waste brine to the Oceanside Ocean Outfall.
