

Failure to submit the 2009 annual monitoring report is a violation of Order No. 94-039. As described in the Notice of Violation, the violation is subject to further enforcement pursuant to the California Water Code. The San Diego Water Board reserves the right to take any enforcement action authorized by law.

You have previously failed to submit annual self monitoring reports for years 2007 and 2008. San Diego Water Board issued staff enforcement letters dated October 14, 2008 and June 3, 2009 notifying you of these violations and providing you with the self monitoring report template. Your failure to submit the 2009 monitoring report after receiving staff enforcement letters is the basis for the San Diego Water Board taking stronger enforcement action.

In making the determination of whether and how to proceed with further enforcement action, the San Diego Water Board will consider both the time it takes to correct the identified violation and the sufficiency of the corrections.

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED THAT:

The Oak Village Inc. (Discharger) violated Order No. 94-039, *Waste Discharge Requirements Oak Village Inc., Oak Knoll Campground, San Diego County*. This violation subjects the Discharger to possible further enforcement action by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board), including administrative enforcement orders requiring the Discharger to cease and desist from violations, or to clean up waste and abate existing or threatened conditions of pollution or nuisance; administrative assessment of civil liability in amounts of up to \$5,000 per day per violation;¹ referral to the State Attorney General for injunctive relief; and referral to the District Attorney for criminal prosecution.

Failure to submit the 2009 annual monitoring report.



- C. To date, the San Diego Water Board has not received the 2009 annual monitoring report, which was required to be submitted prior to January 30, 2010.
