## SUBJECT: SANTA FE VALLEY WATER RECLAMATION PLANT (WRP)

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) has reviewed September 2009 – April 2010 monthly monitoring reports; the July – September 2009, October – December 2009, and January – March 2010 quarterly monitoring reports; and the 2009 annual monitoring report submitted by the Rancho Santa Fe Community Services District (District) in accordance with Monitoring and Reporting Program No. R9-2002-0013.

The San Diego Water Board identified the following violations in the submitted reports:

The 12-month average Discharge Specification B.4 for antimony, established at 0.006 milligrams per liter (mg/L), was violated for the January – December 2009 reporting period with a reported value of <0.01 mg/L.

Please be aware this violation subjects you to possible further enforcement action by the San Diego Water Board, including administrative enforcement orders requiring the you to cease and desist from violations, or to clean up waste and abate existing or threatened conditions of pollution or nuisance; administrative assessment of civil liability in amounts of up to \$5,000 per day per violation;<sup>1</sup> referral to the State Attorney General for injunctive relief; and referral to the District Attorney for criminal prosecution.
