Review of the January-June 2014 Semi-annual Monitoring Report for All

Seasons RV Park

Mr. Beath:

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) has reviewed the January-June 2014 semi-annual monitoring report, submitted by All Seasons RV Park, LLC, in accordance with the Monitoring and Reporting Program of Order No. 94-05, and has the following comment:

1. The Discharge Specifications in Section B.1 of Order No. 94-05 requires the daily maximum effluent limitation for Biochemical Oxygen Demand (BOD) shall not exceed 45 mg/L. The effluent limit for BOD was exceeded on February 5, 2014 with a reported value of 46.0 mg/L.

The next monitoring reports required to be submitted are the July-December 2014 semi-annual monitoring report and the January-December 2014 annual monitoring report, which are due by January 30, 2015.

Please take steps to implement follow-up actions necessary to ensure that the violations noted above do not occur in the future. These violations subject the Discharger to possible further enforcement action by the San Diego Water Board including administrative enforcement orders requiring the Discharger to cease and desist from violations, or to clean up waste and abate existing or threatened conditions of pollution or nuisance; administrative assessment of civil liability in amounts of up to \$5,000 per day per violation; referral to the State Attorney General for injunctive relief; and referral to the District Attorney for criminal prosecution.

The San Diego Water Board is implementing a Paperless Office system to reduce our paper use, increase efficiency, and provide a more effective way for our staff, the public and interested parties to view water quality documents in electronic form.
