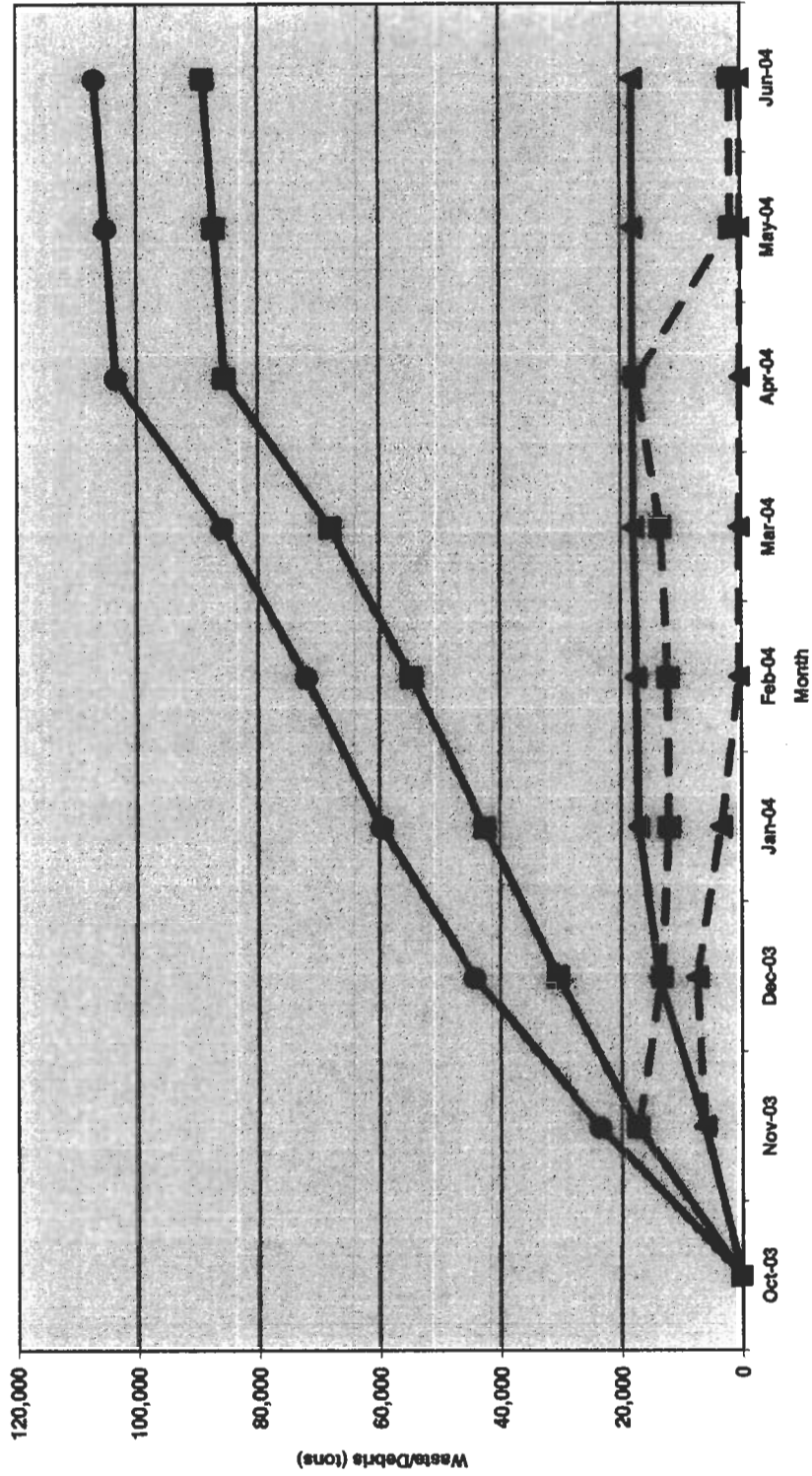

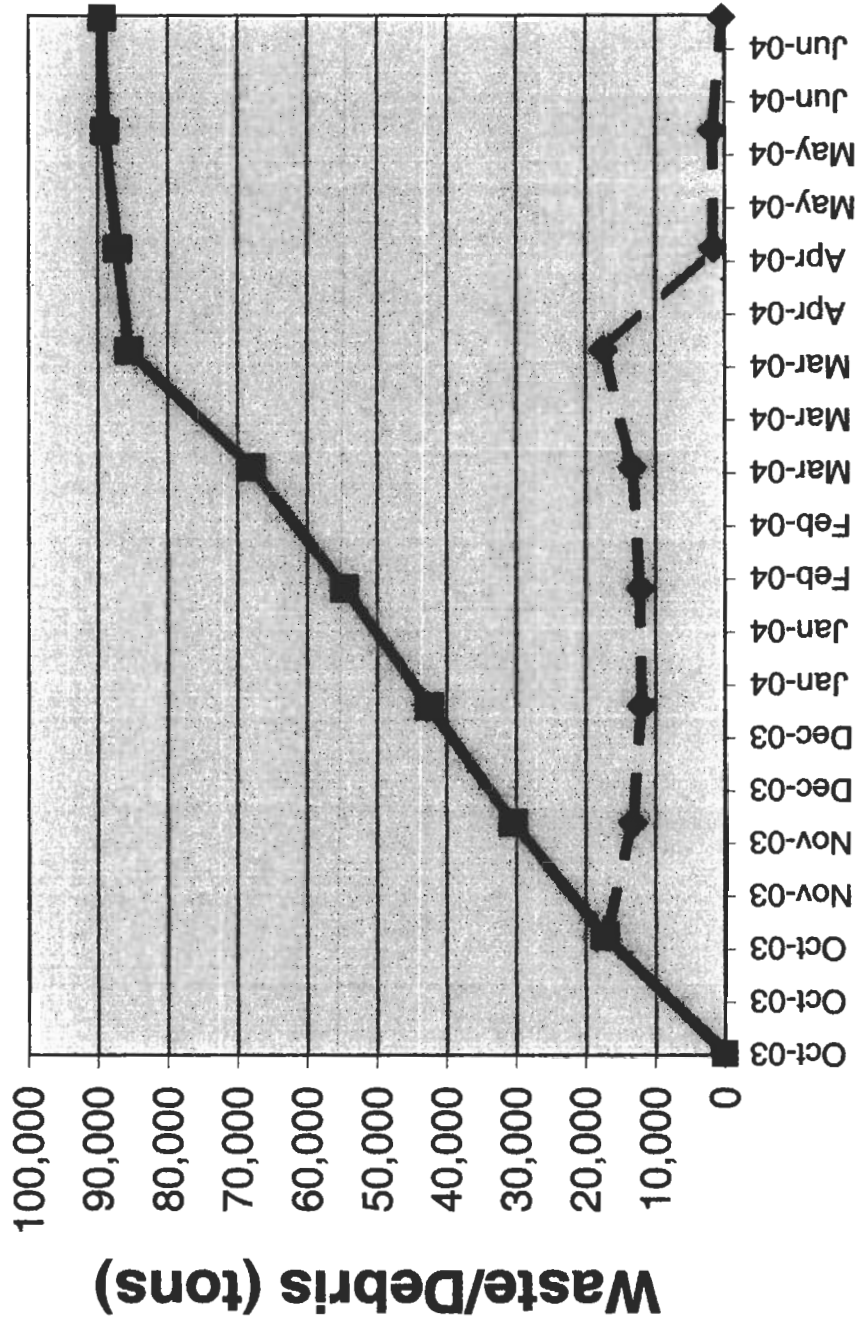

- Cumulative Total All Facilities

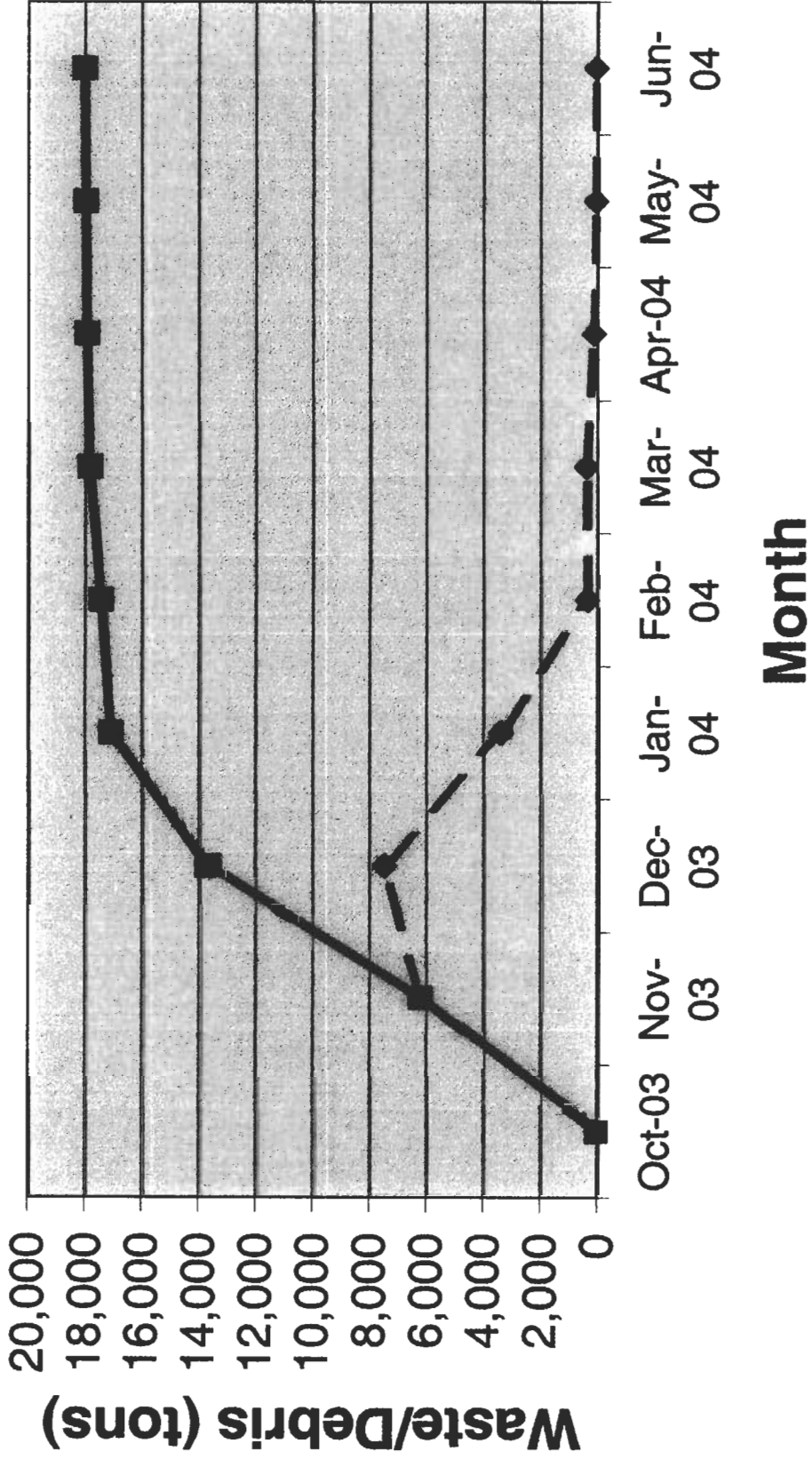
Wildfire Debris: Allied Waste LFs Sycamore, Ramona and Otay Landfills
