

Focused Meeting Stakeholder Representative Selection Process

San Diego County, Orange County, and Riverside County Copermittees

- 1. Each county may select up to 2 stakeholder representatives to attend the focused meetings. The stakeholder representatives from each county do not necessarily have to be the same for every focused meeting.
- The Principle Copermittee from each county is responsible for submitting the names of the selected stakeholder representatives to the Regional Permit Team by email (<u>lwalsh@waterboards.ca.gov</u> and <u>wchiu@waterboards.ca.gov</u>) by May 9, 2012. The following information must be provided:
 - a. Names of selected stakeholder representatives and the meetings they will attend; and
 - b. Contact information (email and telephone number) of the selected stakeholder representatives.

Environmental Community and Development Community

- 1. Members of these stakeholder groups may nominate representatives (including self-nominations) for consideration by the Regional Permit Team.
- Nominations are to be submitted to the Regional Permit Team by email (<u>lwalsh@waterboards.ca.gov</u> and <u>wchiu@waterboards.ca.gov</u>) by May 4, 2012. Nominations must include the following information:
 - a. Name of the nominee;
 - b. Qualifications of the nominee (i.e. experience with MS4 permits and meeting topics);
 - c. Meetings the nominee is interested in and able to attend; and
 - d. Contact information (email and telephone number) of the nominee.
- 3. The Regional Permit Team will notify the nominees if they have been invited to participate as stakeholder representatives by **May 9, 2012**.
