RESOLUTION NO. 70-9

RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 747, AN ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST,
AND RESOLUTION NO. 68-6, WHICH AMENDED THE TIME SCHEDULE OF
RESOLUTION NO. 747, AND COMMENDING THE CITY OF RICHMOND

WHEREAS THIS REGIONAL BOARD HAS CONSIDERED

INFORMATION ABOUT THIS DISCHARGE

1. This Regional Board adopted Resolution No. 721 on February 17, 1966, prescribing revised requirements for waste discharge by the City of Richmond, called the discharger below, into San Francisco Bay at the foot of Garrard Boulevard in Richmond.
2. This Regional Board adopted Resolution No. 747 on April 26, 1966, ordering the discharger to cease and desist violations of the aforesaid requirements, and amended the time schedule of that order by adopting Resolution No. 68-6 on March 21, 1968.
3. On January 29, 1970, this Regional Board received and accepted evidence from the discharger showing that he is substantially complying with the aforesaid requirements and order.

RESOLVED BY THIS REGIONAL BOARD

1. This Regional Board commends the City of Richmond for completion of its waste treatment facilities substantially on schedule with the time schedule of Resolution No. 68-6.
2. This Regional Board's Resolutions Nos. 747 and 68-6 are rescinded.
3. The staff is instructed to prepare revised requirements for this discharge at the earliest practicable date.
