RESOLUTION NO. 70-63

RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 616, AN ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST  
AND COMMENDING THE NAPA SANITATION DISTRICT

WHEREAS THIS REGIONAL BOARD HAS CONSIDERED

INFORMATION ABOUT THIS DISCHARGE

1. This Regional Board adopted Resolution No. 557 on May 21, 1964, adopting a long-range plan and policy with respect to water pollution control within the Napa River drainage basin.
2. Paragraph XII-C-1 of Resolution No. 557 prohibits the discharge of untreated sewage to the Napa River when the flow in the Napa River is less than 2500 cubic feet per second.
3. This Regional Board adopted Resolution No. 616 on November 19, 1964, ordering the Napa Sanitation District to cease and desist violations of Paragraph XII-C-1 of Resolution No. 557.
4. On July 23, 1970, this Regional Board received and accepted evidence from the Napa Sanitation District showing that the District is complying with the aforesaid prohibition and order.

RESOLVED BY THIS REGIONAL BOARD

1. This Regional Board accepts the report dated April 23, 1970, from Napa Sanitation District, as a satisfactory final report pursuant to Resolution No. 616, an Order to Cease and Desist.
2. This Regional Board commends the Napa Sanitation District for completion of its construction projects effecting the separation of all sanitary and storm sewers ahead of schedule.
3. This Regional Board's Resolution No. 616 is rescinded.
