ORDER NO. 71-62

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 68-27 TO PRESCRIBE REVISED
WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE UNION OIL
COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, SAN FRANCISCO REFINERY, RODEO

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region, finds:

1. On April 30, 1968 this Regional Board adopted Resolution No. 68-27,
" PRESCRIBING REQUIREMENTS AS TO THE NATURE OF FIVE WASTE
DISCHARGES BY UNION OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA INTO SAN
PABLO BAY AND ONTO LAND NEAR RODEO, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY ".
2. Union Oil Company of California called the discharger below, informed this Regional Water Quality Control Board on May 21, 1971 of the company's intent to disinfect sewage at its various points of origin in the refinery.
3. This Regional Board has notified the discharger and interested agencies and persons of its intent to prescribe additional waste discharge requirements for this plant.
4. This Regional Board in a public meeting heard and considered all comments pertaining to these discharges.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, the discharger shall comply with the following:

A. Waste Discharge Requirements

The MPN of coliform organisms in waste "2" at some point or points where all its sewage component is present shall not exceed 1000 per 100 ml, provided that:

Not more than 20% of the
samples in any 30-day
period shall exceed 1000 per 100 ml

No single sample when
verified by a repeat
sample taken within
48 hours shall exceed 10,000 per 100 ml, maximum

B. Provisions

1. The MPN coliform organism requirement contained in Resolution No. 68-27 is rescinded.

2. This Order includes items numbered 1, 6, and 7 of the attached "Reporting Requirements" dated August 28, 1970.
3. This Order includes items numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 of the attached "Notifications" dated January 6, 1970.
