
AN ORDER RESCINDING WATER RECLAMATION REQUIREMENTS (ORDER NO. 82-2)
FOR TONY LEMA GOLF COURSE (SOUTHERN PORTION), CITY OF SAN LEANDRO,
EAST BAY DISCHARGERS AUTHORITY, ALAMEDA COUNTY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco
Bay Region, (hereinafter Board) finds that:

1. On January 20, 1982, the Board adopted Water Reclamation Requirements (Order No. 82-2) for the Tony Lema Golf Course (southern portion), City of San Leandro, Alameda County.
2. On May 17, 1985, the Board recieved a letter from the City of San Leandro stating that they do not use or plan to use reclaimed wastewater at the Tony Lema golf course.
3. Water reclamation requirements in Order No. 82-2 are no longer required since no water reclamation occurs or is proposed by the discharger at the Tony Lema (southern portion) golf course.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that a water reclamation order No. 82-2 is rescinded.
