SUBJECT: California Department of Parks and Recreation, Angel Island State Park –

Hearing to Consider Mandatory Minimum Penalty for Discharge of Partially Treated

Wastewater to Waters of the State

CHRONOLGY: One previous MMP.

California Department of Parks and Recreation Angel Island State Park violated its NPDES permit limits four times during the period between October 1, 2002 and February 28, 2003. Three of these violations are each subject to a mandatory penalty of \$3,000, for a total minimum penalty of \$9,000.

The complaint (Attachment A) imposes a Minimum Mandatory Penalty (MMP) in the total amount of \$9,000. California Department of Parks and Recreation Angel Island State Park has signed a waiver to a Board hearing and intends to undertake a supplemental environmental project (SEP).

The proposed SEP is a Native Coastal Habitat Restoration project to restore the native plant communities, specifically planting of vegetation on stream banks. The project will provide habitat for native wildlife as well as protect soil resources and improve and restore natural hydrologic patterns and functions.
