SUBJECT: California Department of Parks and Recreation, Angel Island State Park, Tiburon, Marin County - Issuance of Waste Discharge Requirements

CHRONOLOGY: March 1993 – NPDES Permit reissued

DISCUSSION: Angel Island State Park (the Park) is replacing the existing discharge of secondary treated effluent to Central San Francisco Bay with land disposal to an onsite subsurface land disposal system (leach field). The attached Tentative Order would issue Waste Discharge Requirements for land disposal of secondary-treated wastewater to the onsite leach field. In 2003, the Park designed and constructed the leach field to dispose of all the secondary treated effluent currently discharged into Central San Francisco Bay. Once the leach field is operating successfully, the Park's NPDES permit allowing for discharge to Central San Francisco Bay will be rescinded.

The Tentative Order contains effluent limits and provisions based on the Basin Plan.

We have received no comments on the Tentative Order.
