SUBJECT: City of Calistoga, Dunaweal Wastewater Treatment Plant,

Calistoga, Napa County - Reissuance of NPDES Permit

**CHRONOLOGY:** November 2000 – Permit reissued

**DISCUSSION:** The City of Calistoga owns and operates the Dunaweal Wastewater

Treatment Plant, which provides treatment for domestic, commercial, and some industrial wastewater from the City of Calistoga. After secondary or tertiary treatment, the effluent is discharged to the Napa River from November 1 through June 15. During the remainder of the year, the wastewater is treated to tertiary standards and distributed for recycled water use or stored for future

use or disposal.

We received letters on the Tentative Order (T.O.) from the City of Calistoga, U.S. EPA, and San Francisco Baykeeper (Appendix B). Several issues were raised, and we believe we have resolved them

all. We have revised the T.O. as necessary. The Response to

Comments (Appendix C) provides further details on the issues raised

and the changes made to the Revised T.O. in Appendix A.
