SUBJECT: LEAKING UNDERGROUND FUEL TANK CLEANUP PROGRAM – Status

Report

DISCUSSION: Attached are three tables indicating progress made during the first two quarters

of fiscal year 06-07 toward our underground storage tank (UST) program goals.

We are currently on track to meet or exceed our goals of issuing 30 case closures, reviewing 350 monitoring reports, and preparing 400 enforcement letters. The majority of these letters are enforceable orders for technical reports,

typically requiring investigations to determine the source and extent of

contamination and proposal of a cleanup plan.

We have added two new staff to the program, one in May 2006 and the other in November 2006. This has allowed us to take over management of 65 UST cases, with little disruption in service to the public, from the City of San Rafael

which dropped out of the UST oversight program in June 2006.

We expect that as case loads decrease at other local oversight agencies, we will be called upon to take over their cases as they drop out of the UST oversight program. When this occurs we may need to acquire additional staff resources or

develop other mechanisms to cope with the increased caseload.
