**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT AND PUBLIC HEARING
FOR
RESCISSION OF DISCHARGE PERMIT**

**San Francisco Public Utilities Commission
Drinking Water Transmission System
Alameda, Contra Costa, and Santa Clara Counties**

Board staff has prepared a tentative order to rescind a permit issued in accordance with the Clean Water Act and Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act. This permit regulated discharges from the above discharger's drinking water transmission lines to various water bodies in the San Francisco Bay Region. The rescission would be effective upon the discharger obtaining coverage for the same discharges under a 2014 statewide general permit by the State Water Resources Control Board.

The deadline for receipt of comment on the draft rescission order is 5:00 p.m. on June 4, 2015. Comments must be sent to the **attention of Vincent Christian**. Persons wishing to file written comments on any aspect of this matter must do so no later than this deadline so that such comments may be considered.

The Board will consider adopting the draft rescission during a meeting to commence at 9:00 a.m. on **August 12, 2015**, in the Auditorium at 1515 Clay Street, Oakland. Interested persons are invited to express their views at this hearing.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations Title 23 section 2050(c), any party who challenges the Board's action through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues that were raised before the Board at the hearing or in timely submitted correspondence.
