The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region (Water Board) Prosecution Team and Atlantic Richfield Company (Discharger) have entered into a proposed Settlement Agreement and Stipulated Order. The proposed Settlement Agreement and Stipulated Order impose an administrative civil liability against the Discharger in the amount of \$245,000 based on allegations that the Discharger failed to timely implement offsite remedial action at 441/445 High Street and to submit the corresponding report as required by Revised Final Site Cleanup Requirements Order R2-2011-0052.
