Begin or enhance “no dumping” education efforts to vessel owners	San Mateo County Harbor District	Within six months of the effective date of the TMDL
<p>Submit a plan and implementation schedule, acceptable to the Executive Officer, listing steps to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Evaluate effectiveness and proper performance of sewage collection systems (sewage dump stations, sewage pumpout stations, sewer lines, etc.) for the harbor marina and harbor amenities. 2) Inspect sewer and stormwater laterals and all other components connecting facilities at Pillar Point Harbor to the sanitary sewer system. 3) Prioritize sewer system repairs and public restrooms repairs in the harbor. 4) Establish and implement a protocol to enhance efforts to identify and correct illicit sewage dumping from boats in inner and outer harbor. 5) Begin or boost existing actions to control runoff from loading docks, dumpsters, food service and refuse areas. 6) Prevent fish waste from fish cleaning areas and squid boats from being discharged to the Harbor 	San Mateo County Harbor District	Within six months of the effective date of the TMDL
