## Justification

### Information Supporting Selection as a Hot Spot (Attach additional photos as necessary):

The City of Fremont's Environmental Services Division conducts over 10 creek/street cleanups per year. As a result of these cleanups, the amount of pounds was counted during each cleanup and annually over time. This creek was selected as one of the top seven hot spots that contain the most trash present through either multiple or all the following ways: accumulation, littering, windblown, or illegal dumping.

Laguna Creek Hot Spot receives trash by littering and illegal dumping from a nearby convenience store and gas station. Accumulation of trash in the creek comes from a quarter mile or so upstream that flows through the Irvington District, a major retail outlet area.

Cleanups are conducted along over 1,600 yards of Laguna Creek that includes the Laguna Creek B Hot Spot at least once per year.
