


TRASH HOT SPOT SELECTION FORM

Site Information

Waterbody: stormwater conveyance channel

Site Location: This site is located adjacent to Western Blvd. along the west side of the railroad tracks from Sunset Blvd. on the north to Laurel Ave., 150 yards to the south. The location is upstream of ACFC Zone 2 Line M.

Justification

Staff selected this location due to its proximity to the Hayward Adult School. Historically, this area is a frequent location for illegal dumping of furniture and appliances as well as hazardous materials such as motor oil and paint. During heavy rains trash accumulates in the channel that runs underneath the railroad tracks and enters downstream storm drains. Attached pictures document trash accumulation and dumping along Western Blvd. Staff followed the site selection process outlined in the ACCWP Trash Load Reduction Work Group Hot Spot Selection Guidance document.
