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Justification

Information Supporting Selection as a Hot Spot (Attach additional photos as necessary):

This location was selected because there is a clear and present trash accumulation problem. Spot selection and cleanup of this location would have an immediate and dramatic aesthetic impact and would reduce trash loading downstream in the Mowry Slough. This reach of Line B is downstream from the City of Fremont and residential areas in Newark. However, the primary pollutant source appears to be a paper recycling facility located on Smith Avenue. Paper is the primary pollutant component, but this is location will also allow staff to learn more about other sources and patterns of trash loading.
