

## Justification

### Information Supporting Selection as a Hot Spot:

This location is adjacent commercial (Sequoia Shopping Center), high-density residential, including a high school, and a major transit hub for both SAMTRANS and CALTRAIN. The area experiences a high volume of pedestrian traffic and is extremely susceptible to trash and litter drop. Additionally, the Franklin tributary runs through the Sequoia Union High School site and parallels the shopping center. A small park, Little River Park, with benches and picnic tables, is immediately adjacent to the open channel portion of the Franklin tributary, which then merges into the Jefferson Branch of Redwood Creek in the underground storm drain. These stretches of creek consists of a combination of open lined-channels and underground culverts & storm drains. The Franklin Branch is channelized and merges with the Jefferson Branch of Redwood Creek at approximately latitude 37degrees 29'06" and longitude 122 degrees 13'48" (under the shopping center parking lot).

**Existing Cleanup Efforts:** City routinely performs litter pick-up along the Franklin tributary using the Sheriff Work Program. City annual cleans the Jefferson Branch at open channel locations along the Branch
