Member Withers requested an update, via e-mail, concerning postponed items.

17. Public Workshop - Incorporation of Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDLs) for Bacterial Indicators for Specific Waterbodies in the Middle Santa Ana River Watershed.

Information pertaining to this item is contained in a verbatim transcript.

Bill Rice, Engineering Geologist, presented to the Board the proposed changes to the Basin Plan Amendment for incorporation of TMDLs for bacterial indicators for Middle Santa Ana River Watershed Waterbodies. Reviewing the basics of what was previously proposed at the February 3, 2005 Regional Board Meeting, Mr. Rice discussed the proposed changes to the TMDLs in response to comments and in response to further consideration by Regional Board staff. These changes included: Adding e. coli as an additional bacterial indicator, adding a 10% margin of safety to the TMDLs, Load Allocations, and Waste Load Allocations, setting a compliance date for wet weather season (November 1 - March 31) of December 2025 and a compliance date for dry weather season (April 1 - October 31) of December 2012, changing deadlines for components of the Implementation Plan dependent upon work of Storm Water Quality Standards Task Force, additional minor changes including making fecal coliform provisions ineffective, if e.coli is adopted into the Basin Plan, addition of a Triennial Monitoring Report, provisions regarding industrial facilities and Phase II Non-Traditional MS4 Facilities, and language clarifying the Regional Board's commitment to review and revise TMDLs as needed. Peer review comments were also summarized.

18. Report on Development of a Basin Plan Amendment to Incorporate Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDLs) for Organochlorines for the Newport Bay Watershed.

Kathy Rose, Environmental Scientist, presented an update on the organochlorine compounds TMDLs for San Diego Creek, Upper and Lower Newport Bay, and Rhine Channel. The presentation included the background and history of the TMDLs, an overview of the technical TMDLs promulgated by USEPA in 2002, Regional Board staff's proposed revisions to the technical TMDLs, and staff's proposed Implementation Plan. A public workshop on the proposed TMDLs will be scheduled for a future Regional Board meeting.

19. Status Report on Rialto-Colton-Fontana Perchlorate Investigation.

Kurt Berchtold, Assistant Executive Officer, briefed the Board on current events regarding Emhart Industries' request for a Board hearing concerning the cleanup and abatement order issued by the Executive Officer in February 2005.

Staff has been working with USEPA and Goodrich to identify a scope of work for the next phase of work by Goodrich. Staff anticipates that a proposed agreement with Goodrich regarding the next phase of work will be presented to the Board at a future meeting.

20. Executive Officer's Report.

Staff has been working on TMDLs for Big Bear Lake that will be presented to the Board at the next Board meeting. Stakeholders for Big Bear Lake would like to show the Board some of the implementation items they have been working on. They have offered a tour of those items during the next Board meeting.

Tim Moore with Risk Sciences shared with the Board the different projects that Big Bear Municipal Water District has been working on and extended an invitation to have the August Board meeting at their location in Big Bear Lake.

21. Regional Board Communications.

The Special Board meeting concerning on-site disposal system failures in Quail Valley, scheduled for July 13, 2005 has been cancelled. The sewer system feasibility report being prepared by Eastern Municipal Water District will not be completed until the end of September. A workshop will be held after completion of this report.
