NOTICE OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT WITH THE CITY OF ETNA COLLECTION SYSTEM

FOR ALLEGED VIOLATIONS ASSOCIATED WITH WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY OPERATIONS

WRITTEN COMMENTS DUE NO LATER THAN
5:00 PM, September 28, 2015

On or after September 28, 2015, the State Water Resources Control Board, (State Water Board) or its delegate will consider approval of a proposed settlement with the City of Etna Collection System (City) to resolve alleged violations associated with the City's wastewater collection system. Specifically, the alleged violations involves failing to update and maintain the California Integrated Water Quality System on-line database.

The City and the Prosecution Team have entered into a tentative settlement for these alleged violations, and have agreed to jointly seek the State Water Board's approval of that settlement through the adoption of a Stipulated Administrative Civil Liability Order. Persons may comment on the proposed settlement by submitting written comments no later than **5:00 PM on September 28, 2015**.
