Project Assessment & Evaluation Plan (PAEP)

What is a PAEP?

It is a plan developed by the grantee after the grant agreement is executed that outlines how to assess and evaluate project performance and report on project achievements.

When does a PAEP need to be prepared?

Once the grant agreement is executed. It is the first document that must be prepared and submitted by the grant recipient to the grant manager.

Who needs to complete a PAEP?

All grantees receiving grants or loans from the State Water Board need to prepare a PAEP.

What funding programs do PAEP's apply to?

All loan and grant programs administered by the State Water Board.

Who approves the PAEP?

State or Regional Water Boards grant manager.
