The State Water Board is required to comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) when funding a project. The Environmental Review Unit (ERU) in the Division of Financial Assistance (Division) fulfills the State Water Board's CEQA responsibility by reviewing the environmental documents provided by the applicant and developing the State Water Board's environmental findings. All projects pursuing funding from the State Water Board must comply with the CEQA requirements. The Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) Program receives funds from the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA). In addition to CEQA, the projects must also comply with the applicable CWSRF Program federal environmental statutes and authorities (also referred to as the federal cross-cutters).
