ADOPTION OF INTENDED USE PLAN (IUP) FOR THE CLEAN WATER STATE REVOLVING FUND (CWSRF) FOR STATE FISCAL YEAR (SFY) 2010/2011

This announcement is to inform interested and affected parties of the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) plan to consider adopting the SFY 2010/2011 IUP for the CWSRF Program.

The Division of Financial Assistance (Division) is seeking public comments on the proposed SFY 2010/2011 IUP (Exhibit A). The IUP will be considered for adoption by the State Water Board at the Tuesday, August 3, 2010, Board meeting.

BACKGROUND

The Division administers the CWSRF Program to provide low-interest financing for construction of wastewater treatment and recycling facilities, implementation of Non-Point Source (NPS) projects, and development and execution of the estuary conservation and protection efforts.

The SFY 2010/2011 IUP is required by the CWSRF federal statutes and regulations, and is a condition of the yearly federal grants the program receives. The SFY 2010/2011 IUP outlines the State Water Board's business plan for the CWSRF Program during SFY 2010/2011. It identifies the projects the State Water Board expects to fund during SFY 2010/2011 and the performance measures used to track the effectiveness of the CWSRF Program.

The State Water Board will continue to operate the CWSRF Program as described in the State Water Board Policy for Implementing the CWSRF for Construction of Wastewater Treatment Facilities (Policy) and the Strategy for Implementing the CWSRF for Expanded Use Projects (Strategy).


