This review is also expected to provide insight into the array of environmental issues and problems that occur within this portion of Tehama County. Public meetings will be held in order to develop community input which will aid in the identification of the resources, environmental conditions and issues found within the watershed area. Once a tentative list of these resources, conditions and issues have been developed, the consultant will review statistical and written information. A final assessment report will be prepared which organizes and documents research findings as well as conclusions and recommendations about the watershed area. The conditions found within the Westside watershed will also be described in GIS layers and a database developed by the consultant.</p> <p>b. <b>Long-term Goals:</b> The overall goal of the watershed assessment process is to develop an understanding of the natural and man-made features and process found within Western Tehama County. This information is expected to result in better planning and development within the Westside watersheds of Tehama County. Further, the information and data found in the assessment document, GIS layers and database will be incorporated into the watershed management plan to be developed under separate grant application.</p>
