



PROPOSITION 84 STORM WATER GRANT PROGRAM: DRAFT GUIDELINES AVAILABLE FOR REVIEW AND COMMENT AND NOTICE OF PUBLIC WORKSHOPS

ANNOUNCEMENT:

The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) is pleased to announce the release of the draft *Proposition 84 Storm Water Grant Program Guidelines* (Guidelines). The draft Guidelines contain information on eligibility, the procedures for submitting Concept Proposal and Full Proposal applications for grant funding, and detailed scoring criteria. Comments on the draft Guidelines must be received on Thursday, December 18, 2008 by 12:00 noon. Comments should be submitted via email to: DFA_Grants@waterboards.ca.gov. BACKGROUND:

Proposition 84 Storm Water Grant Program funds may be used to provide matching grants to local public agencies for the reduction and prevention of storm water contamination of rivers, lakes, and streams. A total of approximately \$82 million will be available for grants.
