# SWATF - Scope

- Task force shall provide advice to the State Water Board on its Storm Water Management Program (Funding and Regulatory) that includes, but is not limited to:
    - Program priorities;
    - Funding criteria;
    - Project selection; and
    - Interagency coordination of state programs that address storm water management

# SWATF - Scope

- SWATF member will provide advice on the following documents:
    - Proposition 84 Storm Water Grant Program Guidelines, with specific emphasis on the project selection and evaluation criteria, and funding priorities (Guidelines to be provided to DWR)
    - Comprehensive Guidance Document for evaluating and measuring effectiveness of municipal storm water management programs undertaken and permits issued in accordance with Section 402(p) of the Clean Water Act

## Storm Water Grant Program:

- Scoping Meeting Input Provided to SWATF – April 2008
- Receive SWATF Input for Guidelines – May/June 2008
- Draft Guidelines to Public – August/September 2008
- Board Adopts Guidelines – November 2008
- Application Period Begins – November/December 2008

## Storm Water Regulatory Program:

- Report to Ocean Protection Council (OPC) – January 2009
- Public Workshops Regarding Effectiveness Assessment Document – Summer 2008
- Draft Effectiveness Assessment Document to Public – Spring 2009
- Present Effectiveness Assessment Document to the State Water Board – July 2009
