Capital Improvement Planning and Operation and Maintenance: Using CUPSS September 28, 2010

The job of a wastewater manager, board member or operator is to ensure wastewater permit standards are met, while planning for replacement of equipment and infrastructure before they fail. For this to happen, it is important to have an effective preventative maintenance program as well as a proactive asset management/ Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) for rehabilitation and replacement of equipment and infrastructure. These tools are vital to managerial decision making. Attendees will learn how to conduct a thorough asset inventory, prioritize equipment and infrastructure replacement, develop strategic steps in an asset management plan/CIP, how to develop a capital improvement budget, and locate funding options.
