### NOTICE OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF THE CLEAN WATER STATE REVOLVING FUND (CWSRF) PROJECT PRIORITY LIST (PPL)

This announcement serves to inform interested parties that the Executive Director of the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) intends to amend the CWSRF PPL, in accordance with the authority provided in Section IV.E.3 of the *Policy for Implementing the CWSRF for Construction of Wastewater Treatment Facilities (Policy)*. The State Water Board adopted the current CWSRF PPL on June 15, 2010. Additional projects were added to the PPL on April 12, 2011 (Amendment No. 1). The proposed second amendment to the CWSRF PPL (Amendment No. 2) will add projects that can qualify for CWSRF financing.

Per Section IV.E of the Policy, the State Water Board or the Deputy Director of the Division of Financial Assistance (Division) are authorized to approve financing for projects on the PPL. The proposed additions to the PPL are projects with applications currently under review by the Division, which may be approved for financing in the near future. Adding the proposed projects will allow them to qualify for financing.


