NOTICE IS HEARBY GIVEN to interested and affected parties that the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) will amend the CWSRF IUP to apply for 2009 American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funds. The Executive Director will approve a [revised SFY 2008/2009 IUP](#) to reflect projects the CWSRF intends to fund with ARRA funds and all other funds available to the CWSRF in SFY 2008/2009 and 2009/2010. **The comment period ends at noon on Friday, March 20, 2009.** Comments may be submitted to:

The CWSRF Program provides financing for construction of wastewater treatment and water recycling facilities, implementation of non-point source projects and programs, and development and execution of estuary comprehensive conservation and management plans.

The CWSRF IUP is required by Federal statutes and regulations, and will be a part of the ARRA Capitalization Grant application. The CWSRF IUP will outline the State Water Board's business plans for the CWSRF Program for the remainder of SFY 2008/2009 and the beginning of SFY 2009/2010. In particular, the CWSRF IUP identifies the projects the State Water Board expects to fund during SFY 2008/2009 and SFY 2009/2010.
