

# **Statewide Advisory Committee on Cooling Water Intake Structures (SACCWIS) Meeting Rules and Process**

SACCWIS was convened by the Executive Director of the State Water Board to advise the State Water Board on the implementation of the "Policy on the Use of Coastal and Estuarine Waters for Power Plant Cooling" (Policy) to ensure that implementation plans and schedules established by the Policy are realistic and will not cause disruption to the State's electrical power supply. The Policy was adopted by the State Water Board on May 4, 2010.

SACCWIS includes representatives from the following state departments:

1. State Water Resources Control Board
2. California Energy Commission
3. California Public Utilities Commission
4. California Coastal Commission
5. California State Lands Commission
6. California Air Resources Board
7. California Independent System Operator

SACCWIS is a state body as defined by Government Code §11121.
