Re: Response to, "CONDITONALLY APPROVED APPLICATION PACKAGE FOR DISCHARGES INTO CARMEL BAY AREA OF SPECIAL BIOLOGICAL SIGNIFICANCE"

Dear Mr. Polhemus,

Thank you for your letter dated June 3, 2008, regarding Pebble Beach Company's request for an exception from the California Ocean Plan (Ocean Plan) waste discharge prohibition for discharges into the Carmel Bay Area of Special Biological Significance (ASBS). In your letter, you state that Pebble Beach Company's application was deemed conditionally complete, if by July 31, 2008, we provide (1) the amount of impervious surface area within our jurisdiction, and we either provide (2) a quantitative description of marine life near the discharges and at a reference location or commit to support for and participation in the 2008 Pilot Study for the Stakeholder Regional Monitoring Program underway.

(1): The total area within Pebble Beach Company jurisdiction that lies within the Carmel Bay ASBS Watershed is 1,550-acres; the total impervious surface area is 257-acres or 16.6%. Two supporting documents are attached.

(2): During the conference call on July 10, 2008 with State Water Resource Control Board staff, Bruce Fujimoto, Dominic Gregorio, and Connie Anderson, and the conditionally complete exception applicants, all applicants expressed support for funding the 2008 Pilot Study for the Stakeholder Regional Monitoring Program underway, including Pebble Beach Company. Pebble Beach Company's commitment is made with the understanding that all parties that expressed support will follow through and cost sharing will be done on a pro rata basis. Per Pebble Beach Company's telephone conversation with Dominic Gregorio on July 16, 2008, this commitment along with the information attached fulfills
