



Dear Office of Operator Certification:

I read the proposed regulations posted on the Operator Certification Program website. Would you clarify the meaning of §2670.1? If I understand correctly, a water recycling plant is considered a wastewater treatment plant, and a water recycling plant can be operated by someone holding a water treatment certification of the appropriate level. Does experience gained at a water recycling plant while holding a water treatment license count toward water treatment certification, wastewater treatment certification, or both? It seems recycled water will increasingly be a part of the public drinking water supply, and I was wondering if the above section reflected that eventuality.
