

and 305(b) Report: 2010 Update.

North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board staff have reviewed the Staff Report and Attachments for the 2010 Integrated Report, Clean Water Act Sections 303(d) and 305(b) developed by the State Water Resources Control Board and have the following comment:

Decision #4228 for the "Lower Eel River HA (includes the Eel River Delta)" for "Temperature, Water" needs to be edited so that the "Status" reflects that it is "being addressed by a USEPA approved TMDL". The TMDL was approved by USEPA in 2007, as stated in the decision. This change to the decision would result in the change of this waterbody/pollutant pair from category 5A to category 5B.

For your reference, the changes suggested above have been made in track changes on to a copy of the decision and attached to this letter. The change will need to be made in the CALWQA database and in the State Board's 2010 Integrated Report and the appropriate Attachments.

Decision Pagional Roard Recommendation	Under this section of the Policy, a minimum of one line of evidence is needed to assess listing status. Two lines of evidence are available in the administrative record. Based on the readily available information, the weight of evidence indicates that there is sufficient justification against removing this water segment-pollutant combination from the Water Quality Limited Segments Being Addressed portion of the Section 303(d) List. This conclusion is based on staff findings that: (1) The Lower Eel River Total Maximum Daily Loads for Temperature and Sediment were established by the USEPA on December 18, 2007. (2) Temperature data from McNulty Slough (LOE 5590) were not comparable to the evaluation guideline used to interpret the water quality objective as none of the samples were collected over 7 consecutive days. (3) The data used satisfies the data quality requirements of Section 6.1.4 of the Listing Policy. (4) Pursuant to Section 4.11 of the Listing Policy, no additional data and information are available indicating that standards are attained.	
Regional Board Recommendation	Coast RWQCB staff concludes that the water body- pollutant combination should not be removed from the Section 303(d) List because applicable water quality standards for the pollutant are being exceeded.
