• Replace San Antonio Creek (South Coast Watershed) for siltation with Shuman Canyon and Casmalia Canyon Creeks for siltation.
• Change Arroyo Burro Creek for pathogens to Pacific Ocean at Arroyo Burro Creek for pathogens.
• Reduce areal extent of impairment for Pacific Ocean at Arroyo Burro Creek, Carpinteria State Beach, and Jalama Beach.
• Change Rider Gulch Creek to Rider Creek
• Change delineation of listed waterbodies and or impaired reach for Salinas Reclamation Canal, Alamo Creek, Orcutt-Solomon Creek and Los Osos Creek.
