Dear Jeanine,

In the informational document for the subject draft policy on page 7, paragraph 5 "Nonpoint Source Management Practices", it states "Responsible jurisdictions would be responsible for the collection and disposal of all trash found in or adjacent to surface waters, including along shorelines, channels, or river/stream banks, and would implement an initial suite of BMPs based on current trash management practices in land areas that are found to be sources of trash to a water body."

Request clarification that the requirement be applied to upstream land owners as well as the owners of shorelines. This will help attack the problem at the source.

The Navy has many trash collection programs including assisting local communities with efforts to clean up the bay and local estuaries.
