UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK CLEANUP FUND SCHOOL DISTRICT ACCOUNT

The Underground Storage Tank Cleanup Fund's (Fund) School District Account was established by statute on July 1, 2009, exclusively to assist schools with site cleanup costs for contamination caused by leaking petroleum underground storage tanks. The statute authorizes the School District Account to reimburse Priority Class B, C, and D school district claims.

The School District Account ends June 30, 2012. No new claims will be activated after June 30, 2012. Therefore, the Fund will encumber a specific amount of funding for each active claim to ensure cleanup costs can be reimbursed. All encumbered funds and reimbursement requests submitted must be paid by June 30, 2014. Any funds not liquidated by this date will revert back to the Fund's general account and will no longer be earmarked for school district claims.

Please be aware that after June 30, 2014, claims activated under the School District Account that have not completed site cleanup and submitted all costs for reimbursement may be placed back on the priority list with their original priority class and ranking. The claim will not be reactivated and funded again until the priority class and ranking are reached for funding. Claimants placed back onto the priority list will be notified.

In order to encumber the appropriate amount of funding for each claim, the Fund is requesting updated information regarding the cleanup activities and costs at your site.
