Although we understand the board's intention of closing this LUST case based on low risk/threat from groundwater contamination emanating from offsite source, I would like to know if you reviewed 2005 phase II report conducted at the site which shows elevated concentrations of MTBE (as high as 48000ppb) in 5' soil samples surrounding the current USTs.
