

## **NON-RECOVERY FROM OTHER SOURCES DISCLOSURE CERTIFICATION**

### **Purpose of Form**

The “Non-Recovery from Other Sources Disclosure Certification” Form (Form) is used to ensure that the claimant has not received double payment for corrective action costs or third party compensation claims. Fund Regulations prohibit such double payment or “double recovery”. (CCR, Title 23, Section 2812.3.)

The Form is a required supplement to the claim application. It must be filled out and signed by the claimant and any joint claimant(s), or by a designated attorney-in-fact. All signatures must be originals, signed, and dated in blue ink.

On the Form, the claimant must identify money for costs related to the claim that have received or expect to receive from any source, including but not limited to insurance claims, legal judgments, and contributions from other potentially responsible parties. Although only payment for corrective action costs could constitute double recovery because those are the only costs that the Fund reimburses, the claimant must identify any payment related to or made in consideration for the unauthorized release that is the subject of the claim, no matter how the payment is characterized. The Form also serves to identify other parties who may be involved in the cleanup that is the subject of the claim.

### **Submitting the Form**

To maintain up-to-date information for each claim, the Form must be submitted every three years to the Fund. If a final reimbursement request is being submitted to the Fund, the Form must be executed and received within one year of the final reimbursement.

### **Failure to Submit the Form**

If the Fund does not have a current Form on file for the claim, your reimbursement may be held until the Form is received.
