The City of Anaheim Public Utilities Department concurs with the CEC Advisory Panel's conclusion that using recycled water for landscape irrigation poses insignificant risks to groundwater and public health and that monitoring for health-based CECs and performance-based indicator CECs is not necessary for these applications. We believe this an important determination in making the use of recycled water feasible in the State of California.
