


Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the Staff Report, *Constituents of Emerging Concern (CEC) Monitoring for Recycled Water* (November 8, 2010).

We are interested in the Staff's response to the following comment:

The Staff Report provides the advisory panel's recommendations for monitoring CEC's in municipal recycled water for groundwater recharge/reuse (as defined in footnote 7 on page 3) and for landscape irrigation.

Our facility's Master Reclamation Permit identifies the following existing and anticipated beneficial uses:

- 1) Municipal and Domestic Water Supply
- 2) Agricultural Water Supply

**Question:** Did the advisory panel provide any recommendations for monitoring CEC's in municipal recycled water for these beneficial uses?
